American Angus Association welcomes two new regional managers to its team.

Recently, the American Angus Association announced two new additions to its team of regional managers. Drew Feller of Wisner, Neb., began his role Sept. 6, and will represent Region 7, which includes the states of Colorado and Nebraska. Mark Sims of Edmond, Okla., began his role Oct. 4 and will represent Region 13, which consists of Alabama, Arkansas, Louisiana and Mississippi.

Regional managers are the boots on the ground for the Association and serve throughout 13 membership regions across the United States. As a partner for Angus breeders and others who rely on Angus genetics, Sims and Feller will be responsible for helping cattle producers identify herd goals, learn new programs and services, and drive quality within their operations.

Feller and Sims will represent the Angus breed at various cattle events, sales, shows and other activities throughout the territory. Breeders are encouraged to ask them questions about Association programs and services, or for help locating Angus seedstock.

The two can also advise producers on marketing opportunities available through the Association, including advertising through the *Angus Journal*, *Angus Beef Bulletin*, *The Angus Report* and other avenues.

Kansas, Oklahoma and Texas. He assisted cattle producers with marketing their genetics nationwide, including targeted advertising and promotion plans.

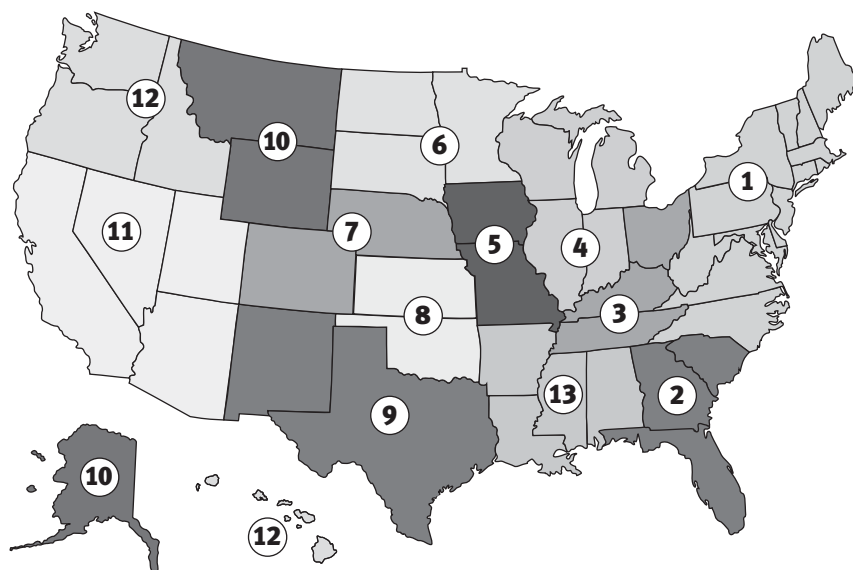
